Chainsaw – Instructions for use



PRE-START CHECKS

- -Fuel tank is full
- -Chain is lubricated (Chain oil)
- -Remove chain protector
- -Check chain tension

STARTING PROCEDURE

DO NOT DROP START THE CHAINSAW

- 1. Engage chain brake where applicable
- 2. Move stop/start switch to start
- 3. Cold start engage the choke
- 4. Warm start disengage the choke
- 5. Depress throttle trigger and lock into place with throttle lock
- 6. Place left hand on handle and right foot into rear of handle
- 7. When engine is running release the starting throttle lock by squeezing trigger
- 8. Disengage chain brake where applicable

OPERATION

- -Always wear the required safety equipment
- -Always hold the chainsaw firmly with both hands
- -Do not stand over or directly behind the chainsaw while operating
- -Always keep a slight downward pressure on the chainsaw when cutting, release pressure when coming to the end of a cut
- -Use the spiked bumper against the wood to help steady the chainsaw
- -Periodically check oil and fuel
- -NEVER CUT UPWARDS

STOPPING AND AFTER USE

- 1. Move stop/start switch to stop
- 2. Engage chain brake
- 3. Re-fit chain protector

SAFETY PRECAUTIONS WARNING

Have a clear working area

Check for overhead wires

Keep away from leads

Be aware of falling branches

Always carry chainsaw with the blade to the rear and

Be aware of long hair and loose fitting clothing Have a planned retreat when cutting down a tree

HAZARDS A DANGER!

DO NOT DROP START THE CHAINSAW

Do not spill fuel

Do not cut over head

Do not cut into the ground (ie. Dirt, cables, pipes, stones)

Do not cut light material (ie. bamboo or hedges)

Do not use in damp or wet conditions

Do not use the chainsaw in the presence of children

Do not use the end of the saw to cut

Do not use for purpose not intended e.g steel

Do not cut upwards
